Social skills groups:

Boost! social skills classes are taught using curriculum from Michelle Garcia Winner, Jed Baker and others. We design each class lesson on the specific needs of the class members. Therefore, no two class sessions follow the exact same curriculum. Our lessons heavily focus on the concept of "Theory of Mind", which involves working with children to help them understand their own and others thoughts, emotions, and intentions.

Skill areas students may work on include but are not limited to conversation skills, cooperative play skills, friendship management, self-regulation, empathy, and conflict management. We use evidence-based practices to guide the structure of our groups, which include a check in, instruction, practice, and feedback with reinforcement.

Social Communication Groups:

Boost! is now offering social communication groups for children lead by a licensed Speech Therapist. These classes will focus on pragmatic language skills, which include understanding the meaning of what is being said as well as using language appropriately in social situations.

Preschool play skills groups:

In this group, children ages 3-5 will have the opportunity to work on beginning play skills, understanding and dealing with emotions, and group skills. This class is ideal for children who may not have a medical and/or educational diagnosis relating to social skills difficulties, but do need a "boost" in increasing their social skills. This group will also be appropriate for children receiving ECSE programming as a supplement to work in-depth on social/emotional development.

Social Skills, Social Communication, and Preschool Play Skills Classes begin the week of June 14th and end the week of August 23rd. There is no class the week of July 5th.

One-on-one support:

If your child has behavioral needs that require one-on-one support in school, we will also require one-on-one support in our classes and camps to ensure all students are able to participate fully and safely in our programs. If your child has a PCA, we are happy to have that person provide the support needed during the class. Otherwise, we will provide the support at a cost of \$12.50 per hour. Please indicate on the registration form your need for Boost! to provide one-on-one support.

Individual Tutoring:

One-on-one tutoring sessions are available with one of our licensed teachers. Sessions are 60 minutes in length. With you and your child, Boost! educators will develop a plan for your specific needs to help him or her develop the skills needed to succeed in life. In addition to traditional academic tutoring, we are able to provide developmental tutoring for young children (birth to five) who may be demonstrating delays in various areas. We also provide individual social skills training/tutoring for children with low receptive language/joint attention skills.

Tutoring is available at Boost!, your home, or other public location. Sessions Price: \$40 per session (1 hour). Please contact us if you are interested in setting up tutoring for the summer.

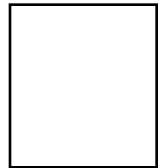
